TOTAL CLIENTS SERVED WITH OLDER AMERICANS ACT FUNDS FFY 2016 VS FFY 2017





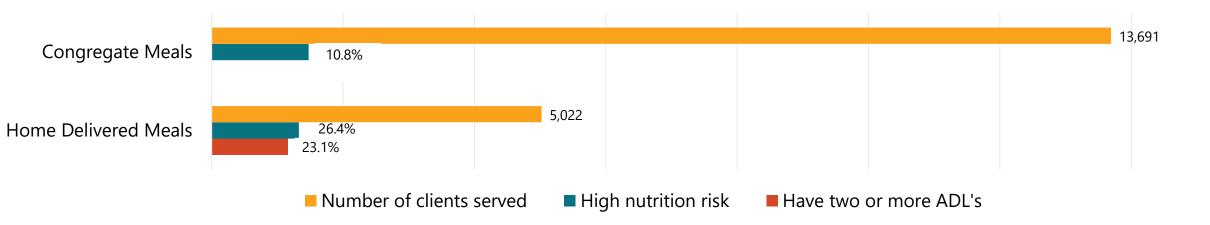




FFY 2017 NUTRITION SERVICES INDIVIDUALS SERVED





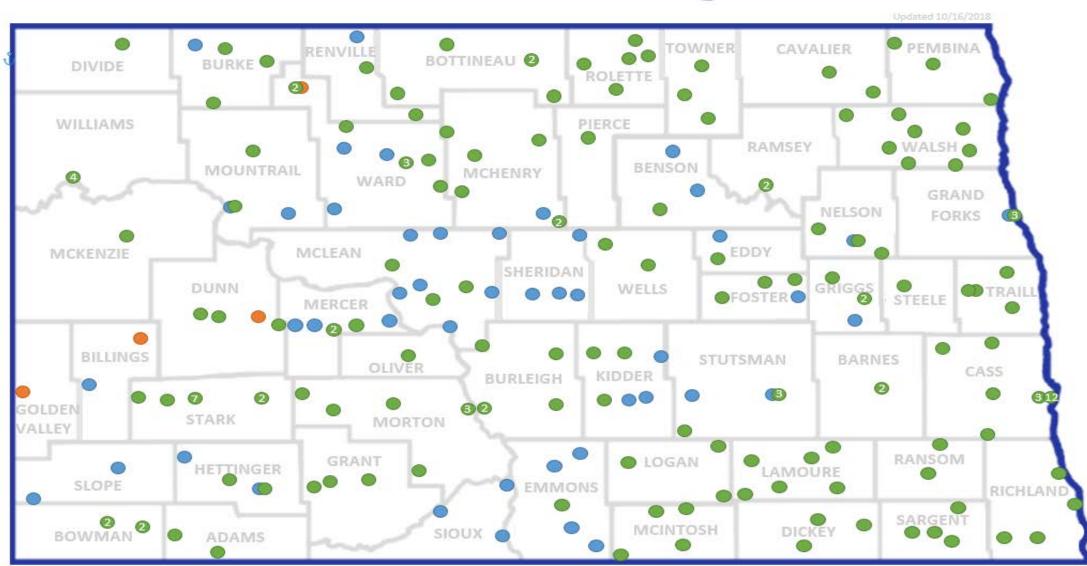


NORTH DAKOTA OLDER AMERICANS ACT NUTRITION SITES

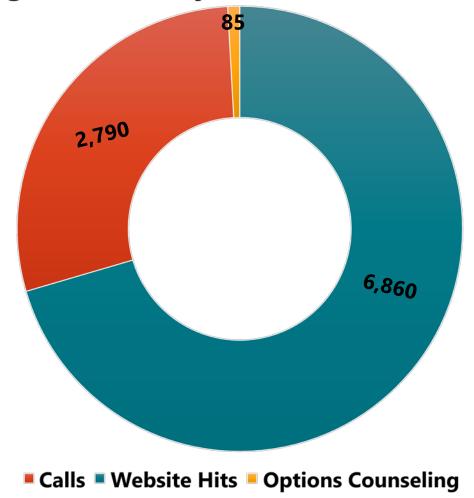

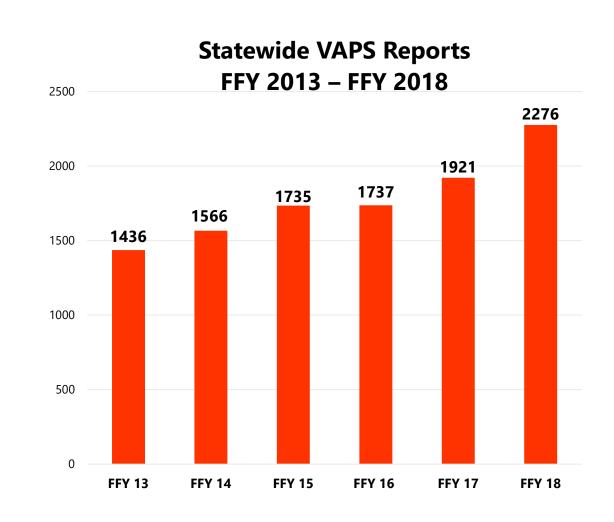

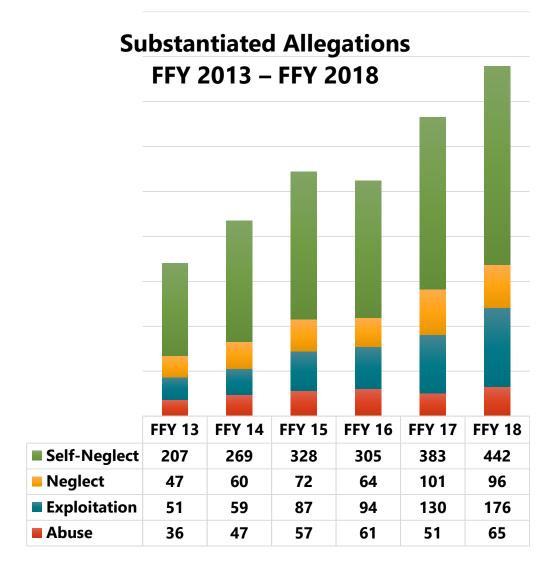
Vulnerable Adult Protective Services (VAPS)

- 2,276 reports received in FFY 2018
- 1,305 reports were investigated that involved 1,405 allegations
 - Average 90 cases per worker
- 18% increase from FFY 2017
- 58% increase after mandatory reporting law passed in FFY 2013
- Nationally, for every reported case 24 go unreported*



Vulnerable Adults

- Of the 1,405 allegations investigated; 779 were substantiated
- Self-neglect is the most common allegation
- 35% increase in substantiated allegations of financial exploitation from FFY 2018

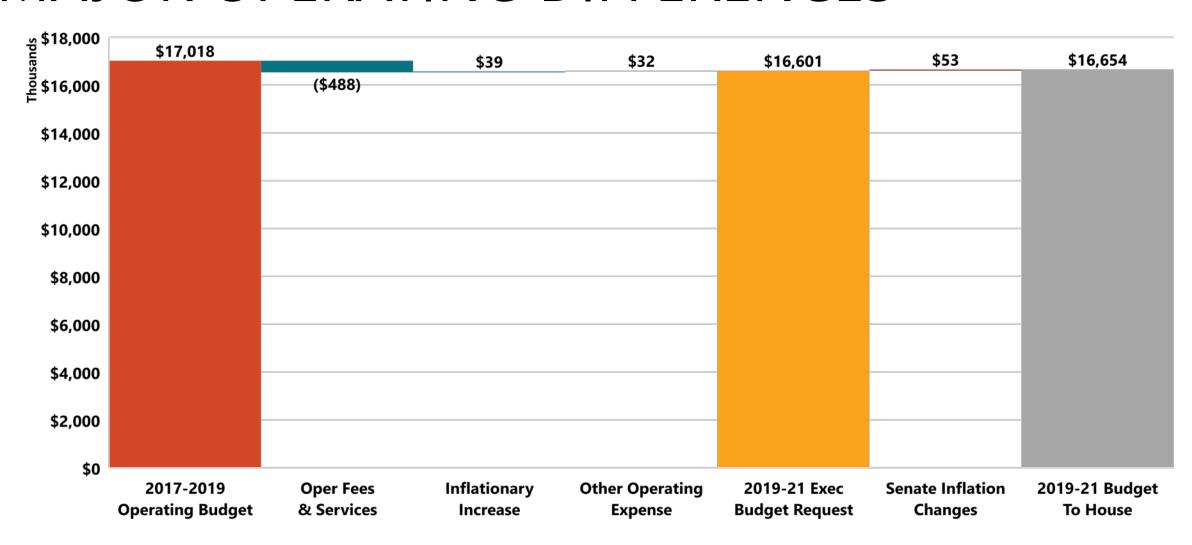

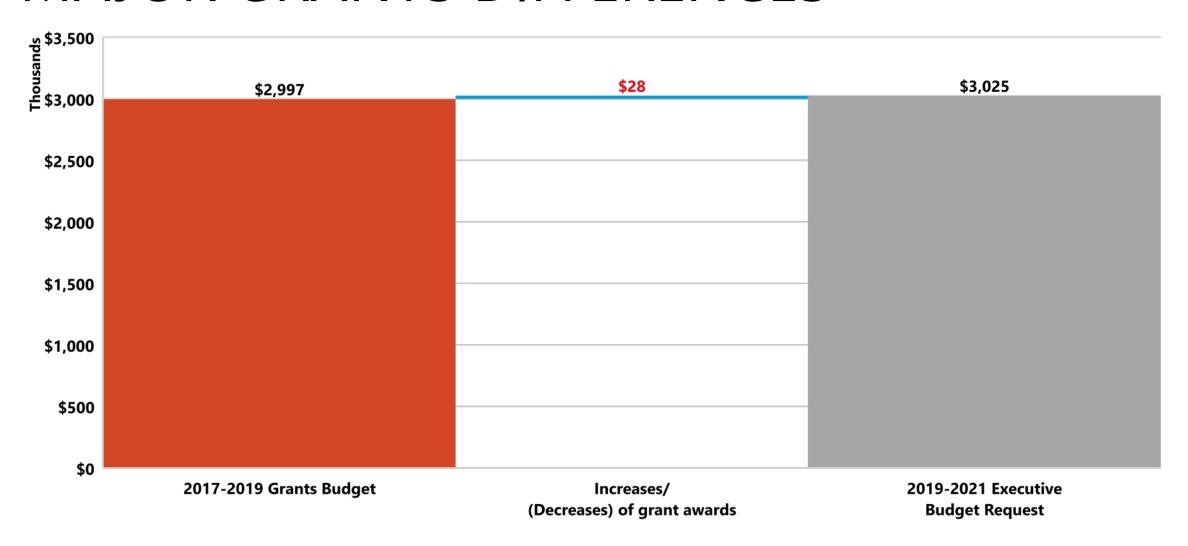
MAJOR SALARY/BENEFITS DIFFERENCES



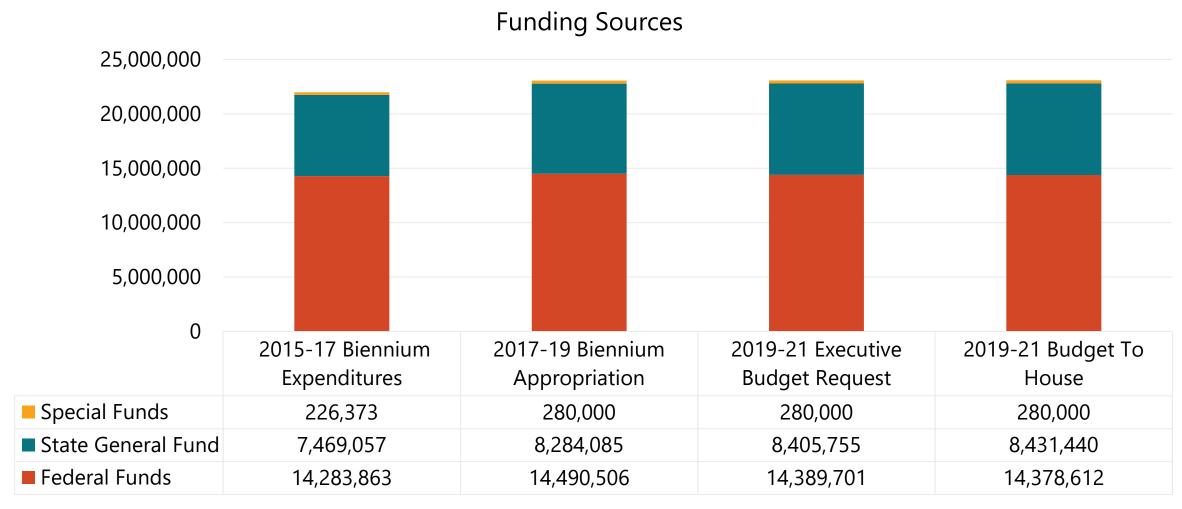
MAJOR OPERATING DIFFERENCES
