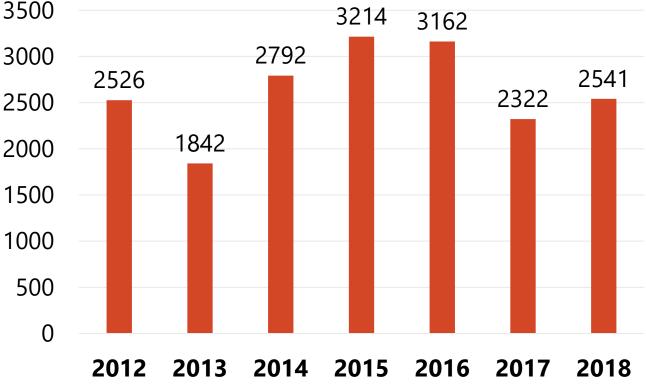

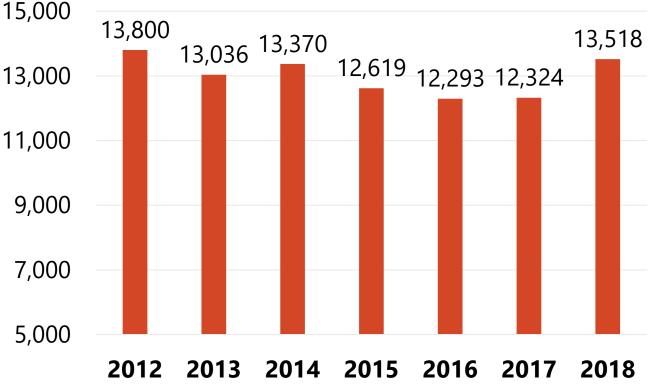
### Number of Children Monthly Average

Number of Households By Heating Season\*

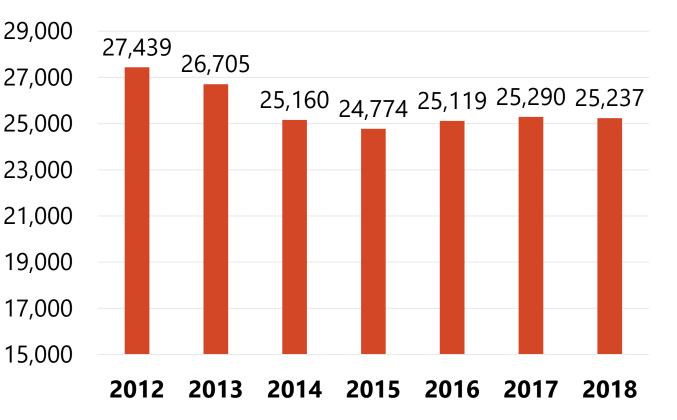

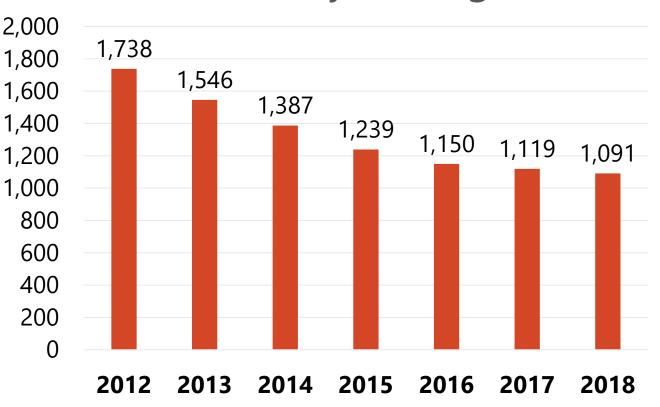
### Number of Households Monthly Average

### Number of Households Monthly Average



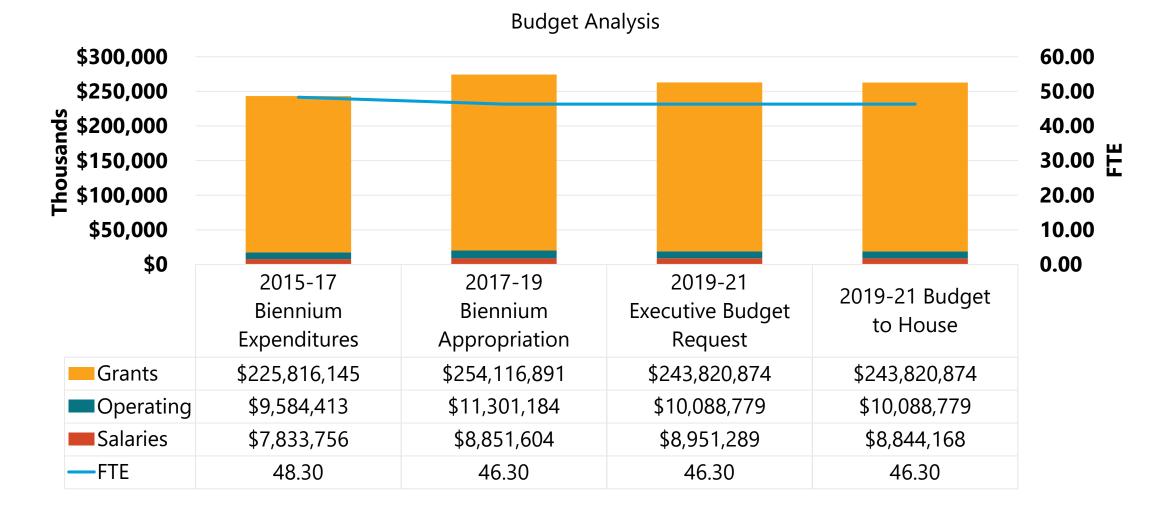

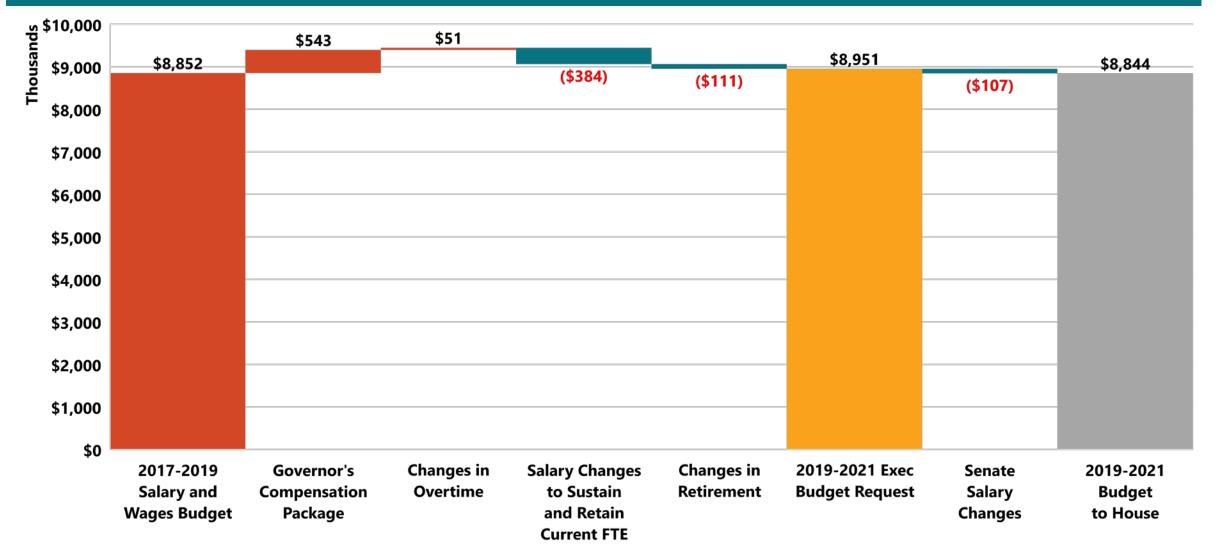

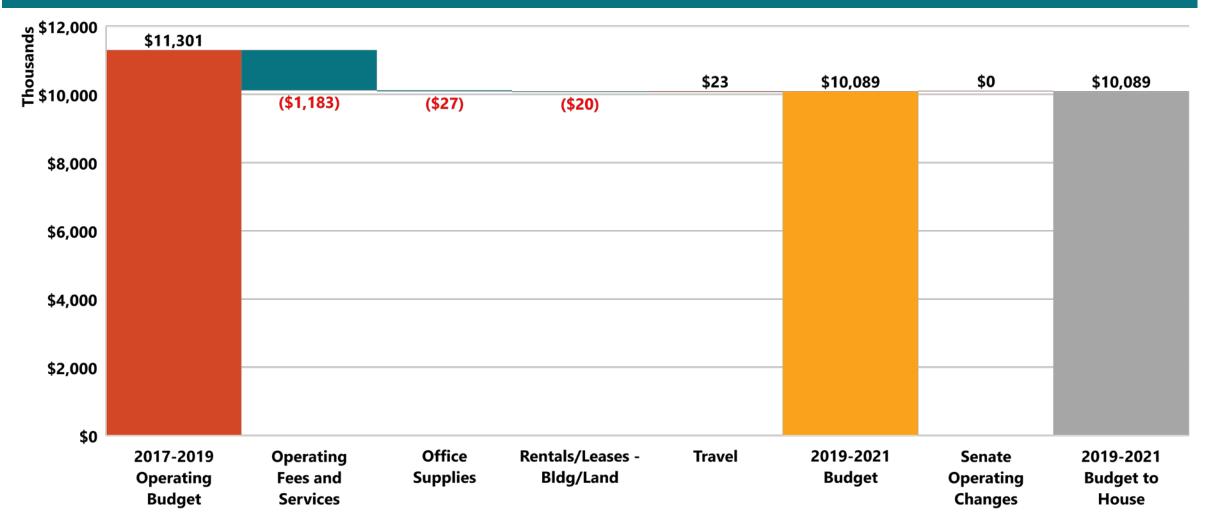

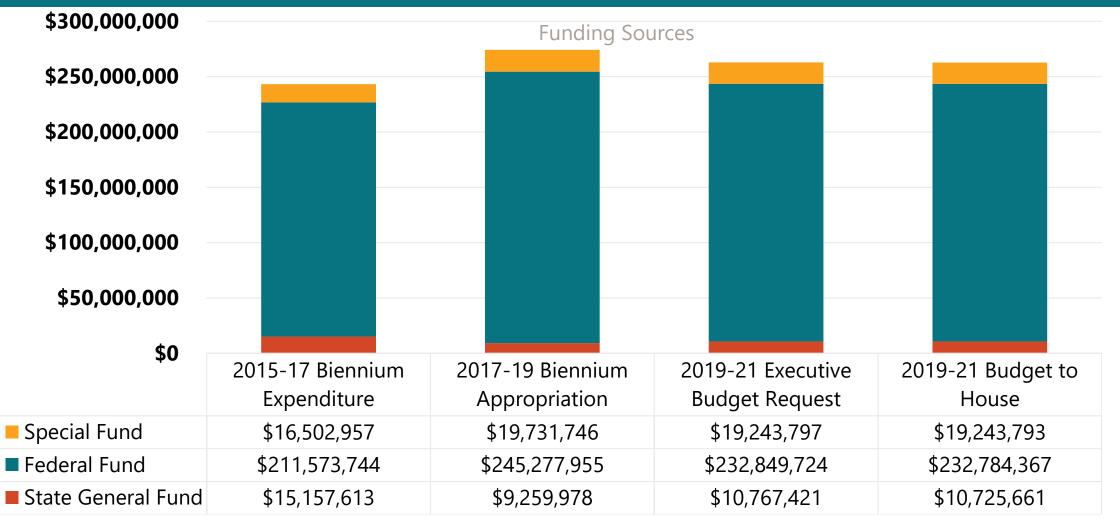
### MAJOR SALARY AND WAGES DIFFERENCES
