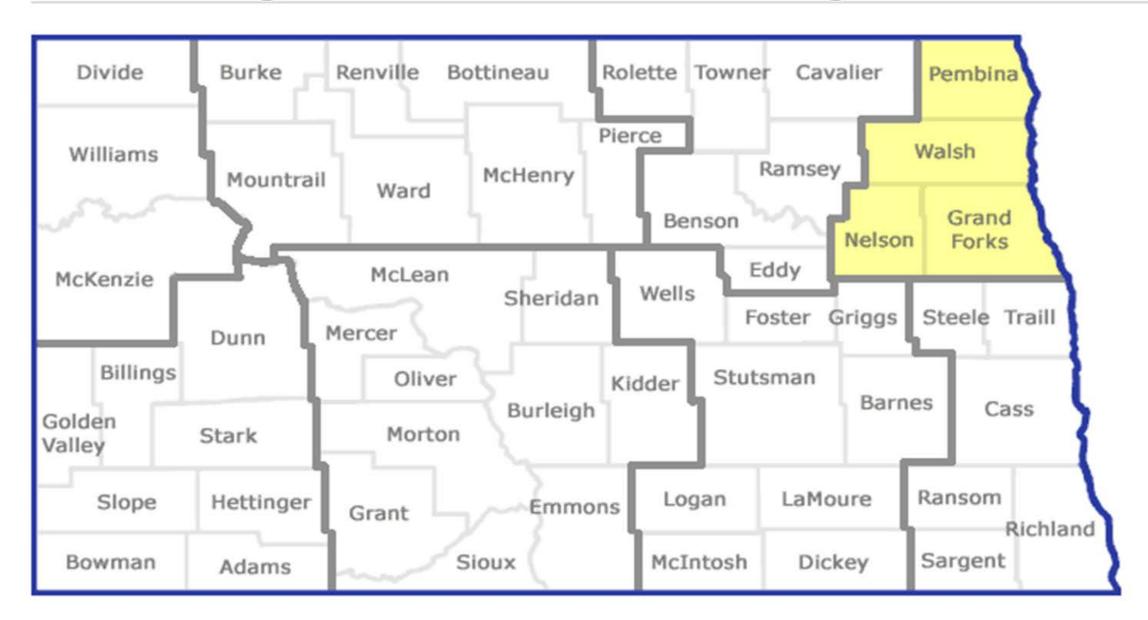

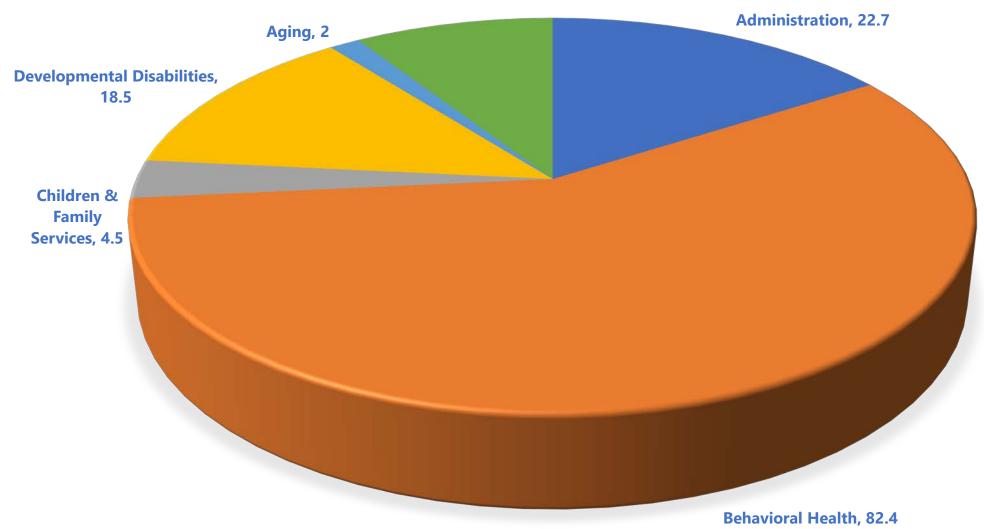

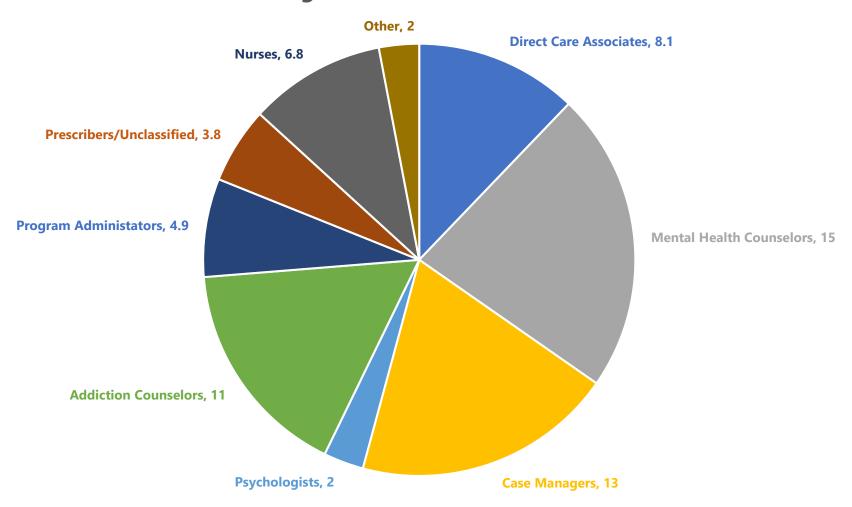


### **BREAKDOWN OF NEHSC 143.1 FULL TIME EQUIVALENT (FTE)**

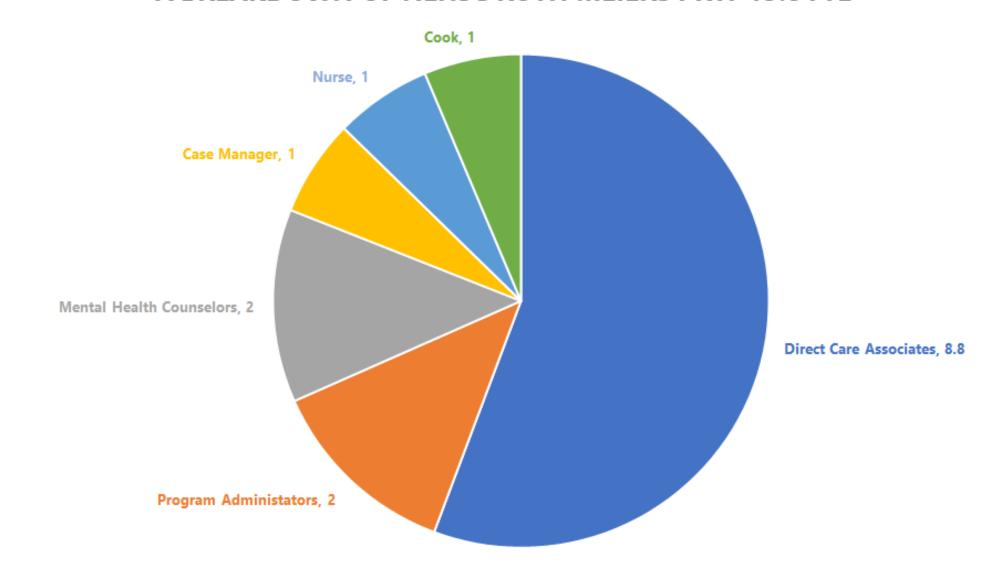




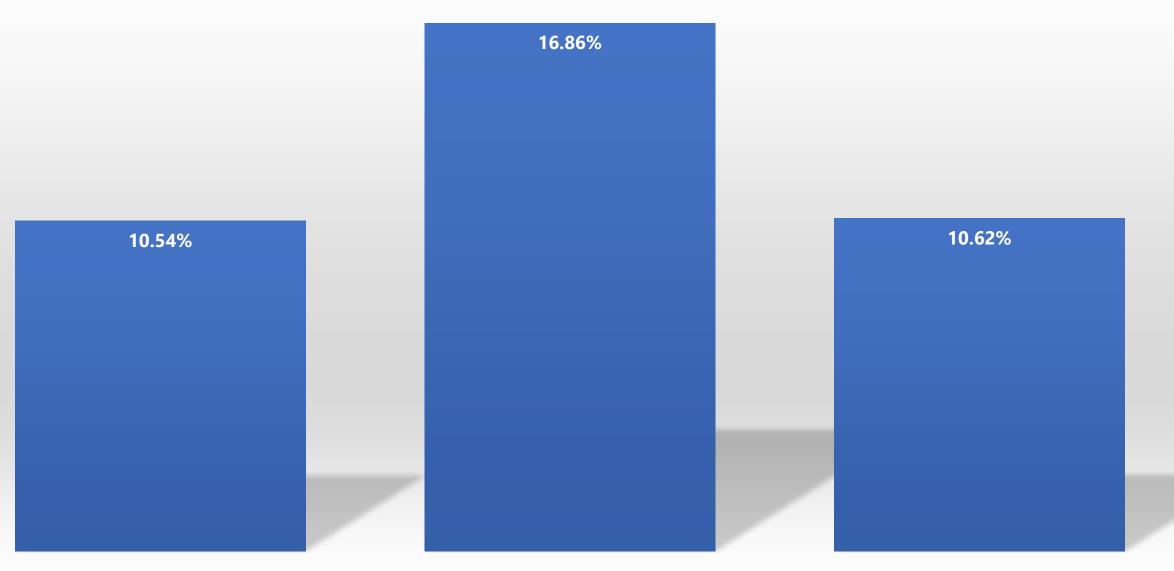
# A BREAKDOWN OF NEHSC BEHAVIORAL HEALTH 66.6 FTE excluding Ruth Meiers PRTF



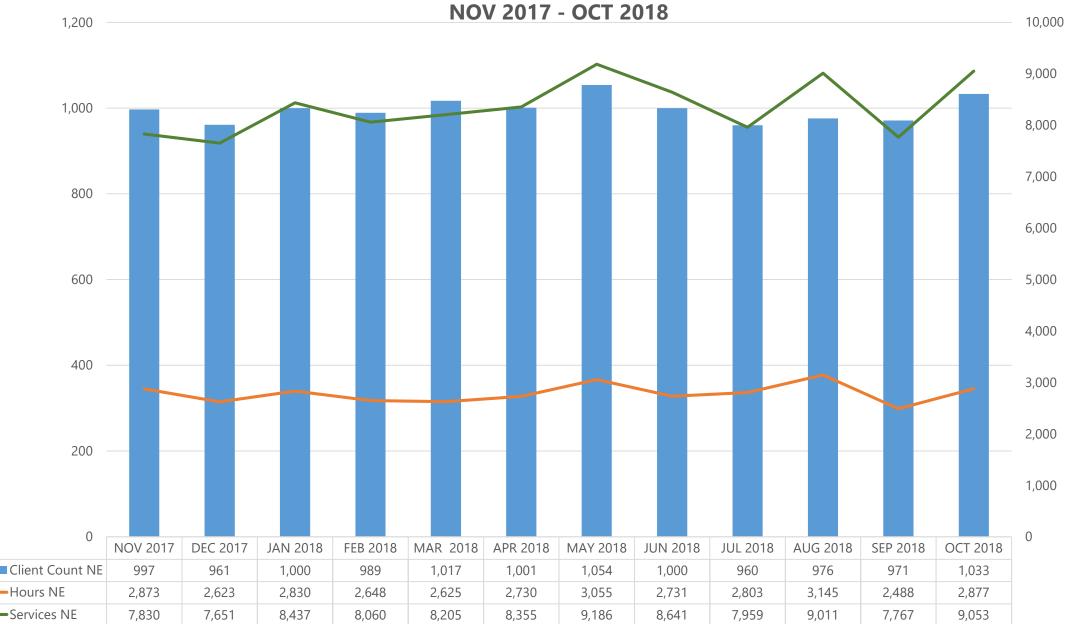
### A BREAKDOWN OF NEHSC RUTH MEIERS PRTF 15.8 FTE

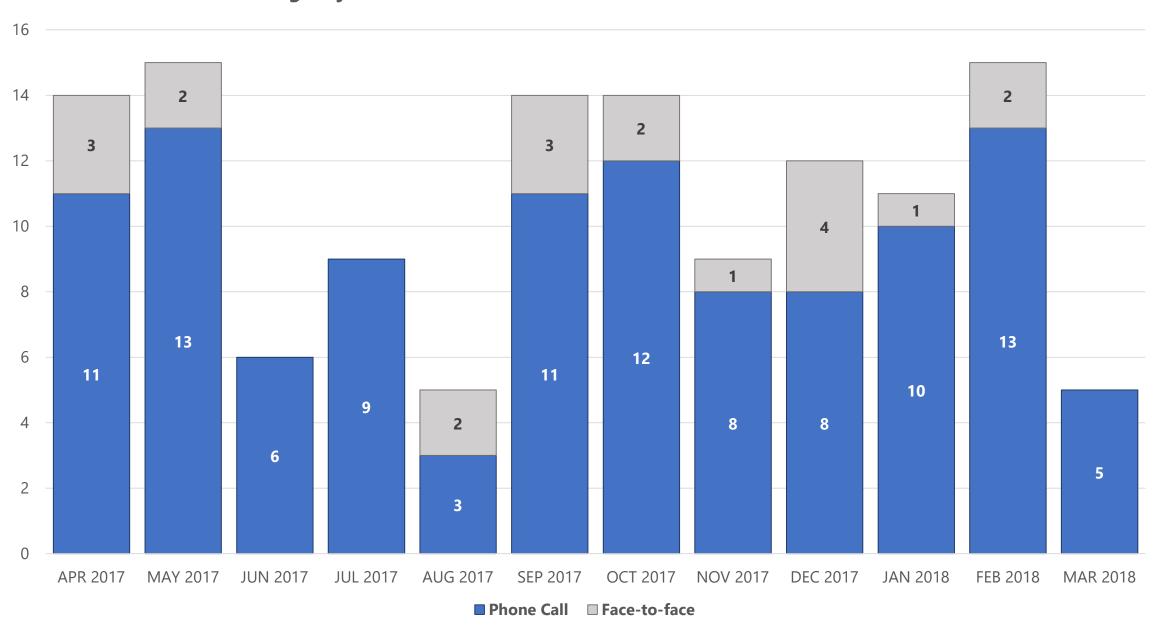

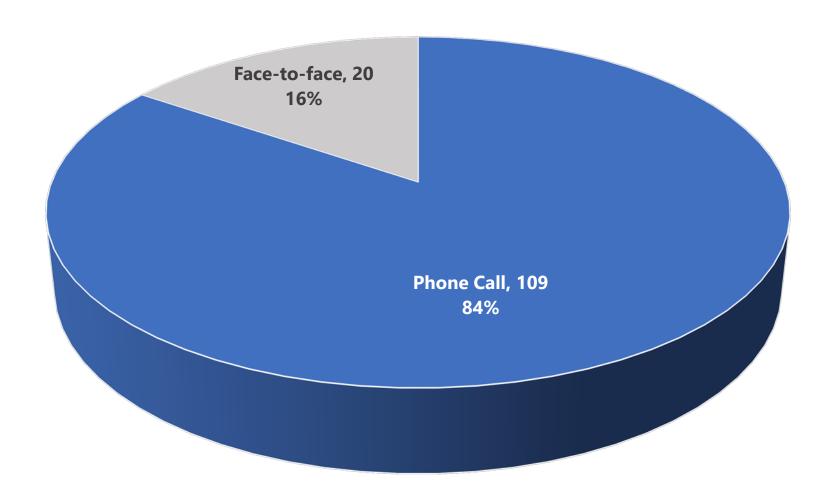

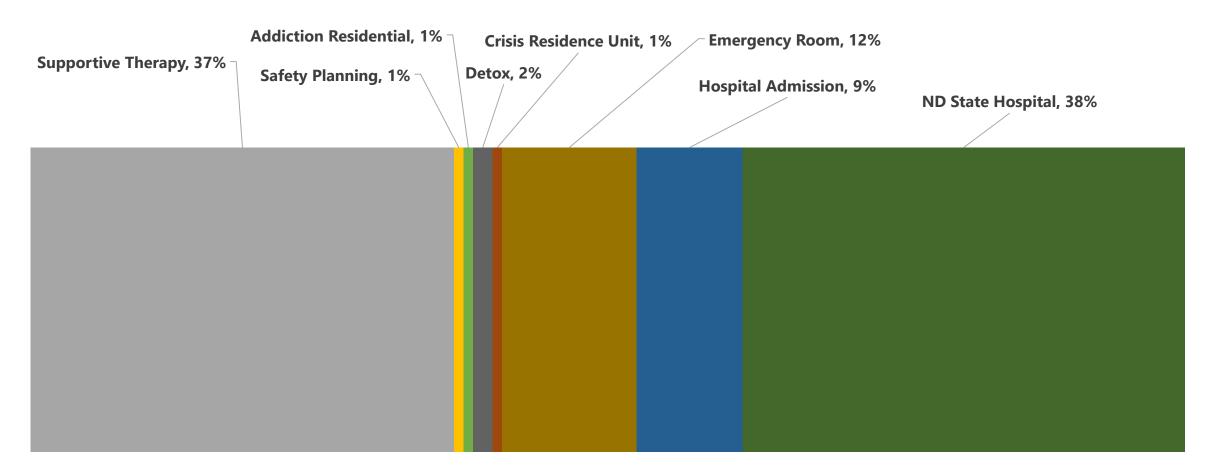
### Count of Emergency Services Face-to-Face and Phone Calls, NEHSC, APR 2017 - MAR 2018



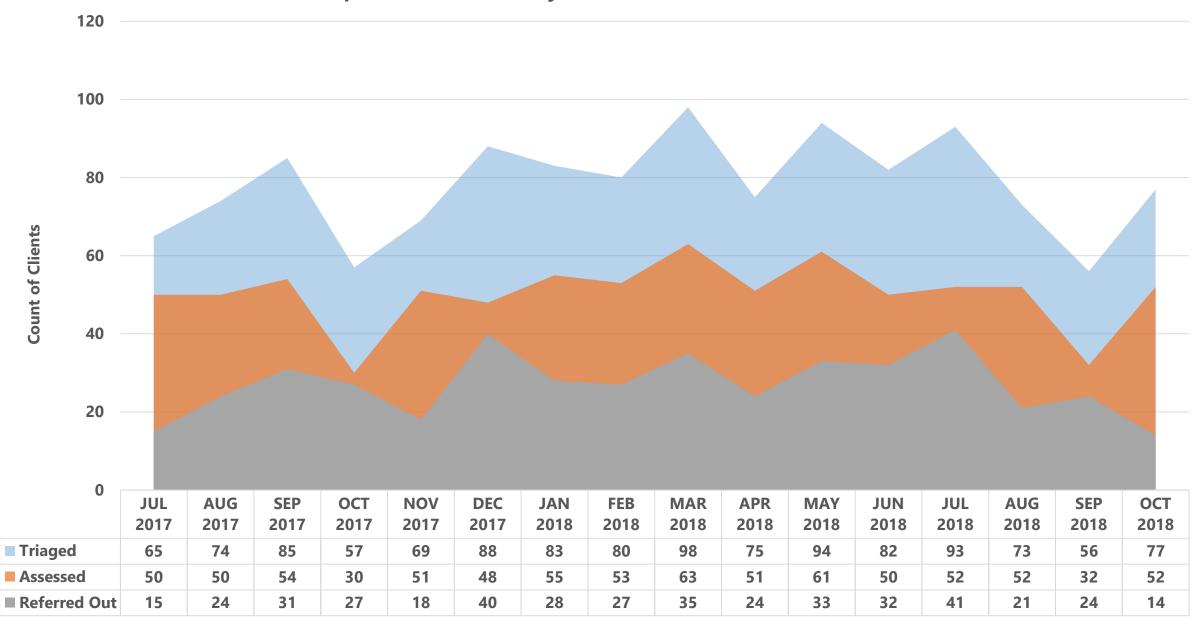
### Counts and Percentages of Face-to-Face and Phone Call Emergency Services, NEHSC from APR 2017 through MAR 2018



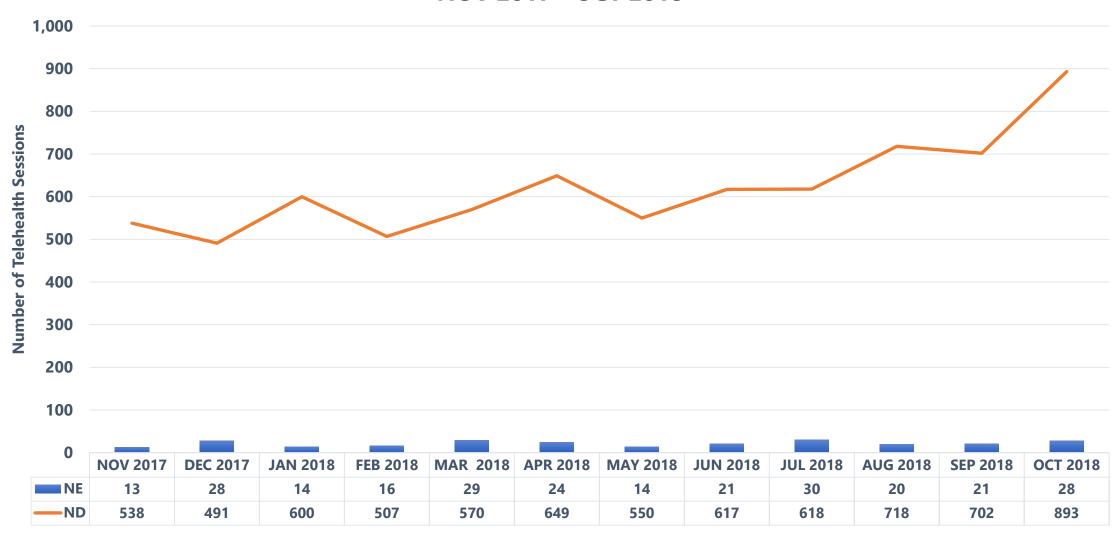
### **Emergency Services Disposition NEHSC, APR 2017 - MAR 2018**



### Open Access NEHSC by Month, JUL 2017 - OCT 2018



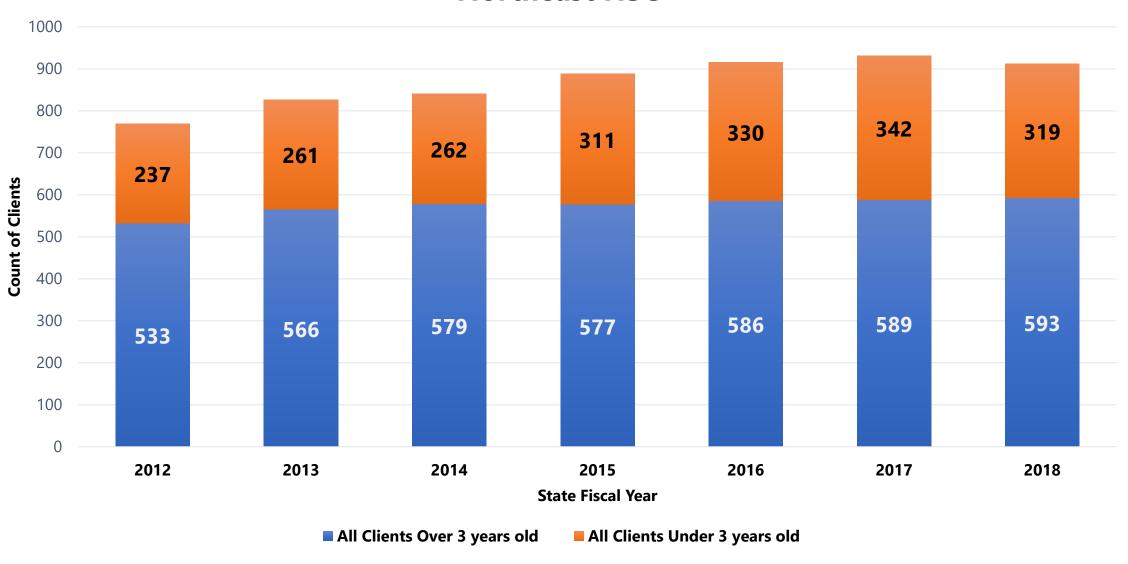

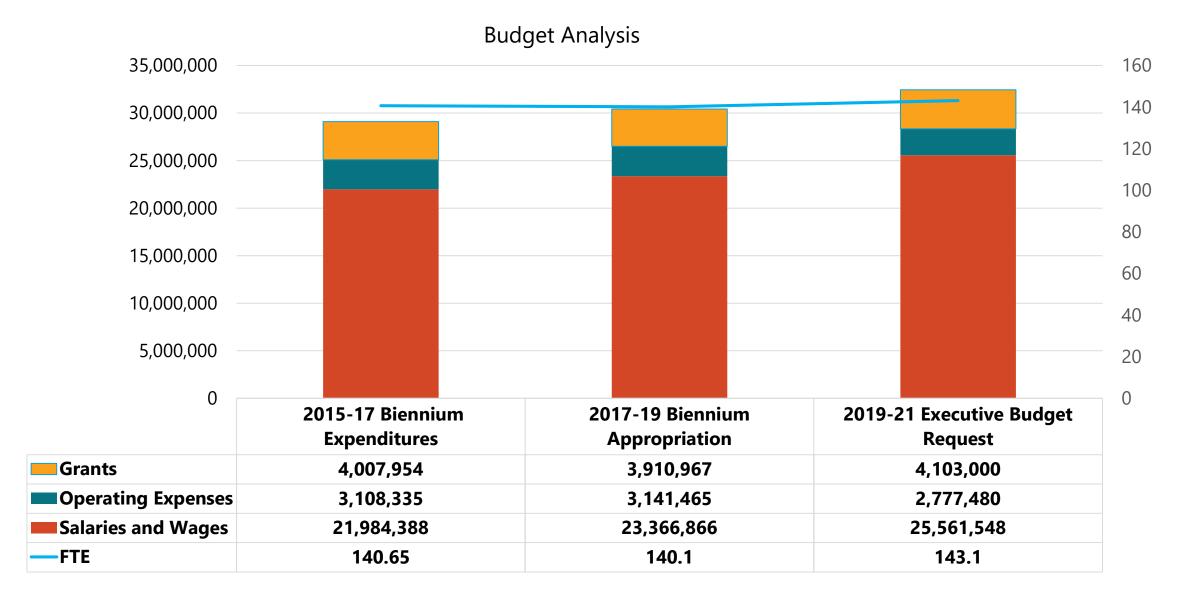
# Number of Children in Foster Care on the Last Day of the State Fiscal Year Northeast Region



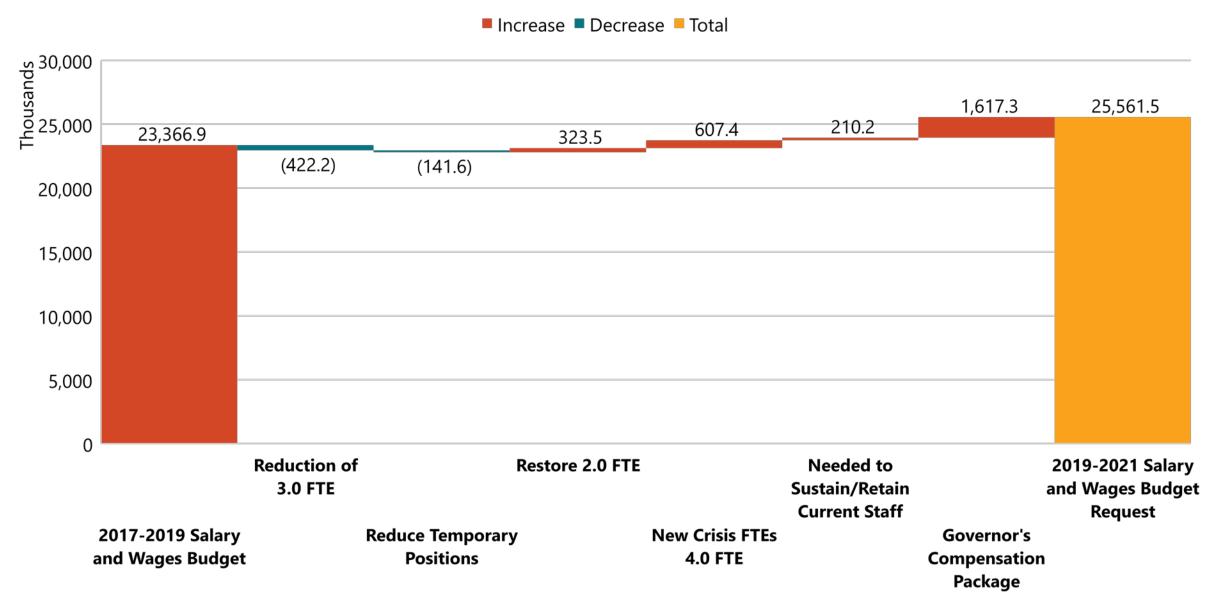

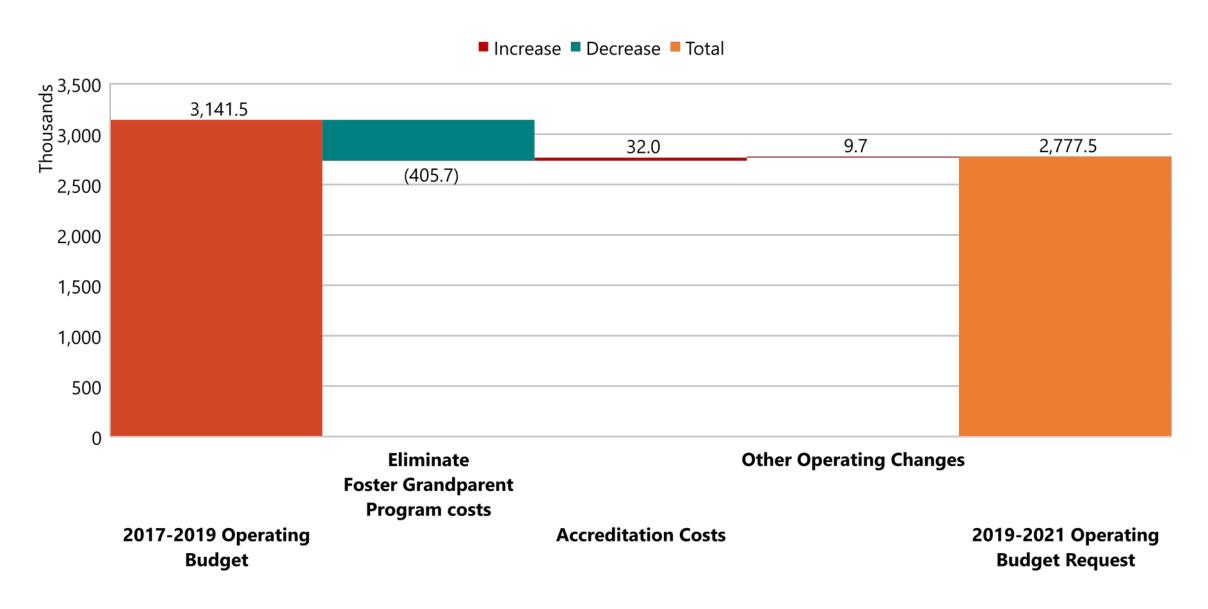

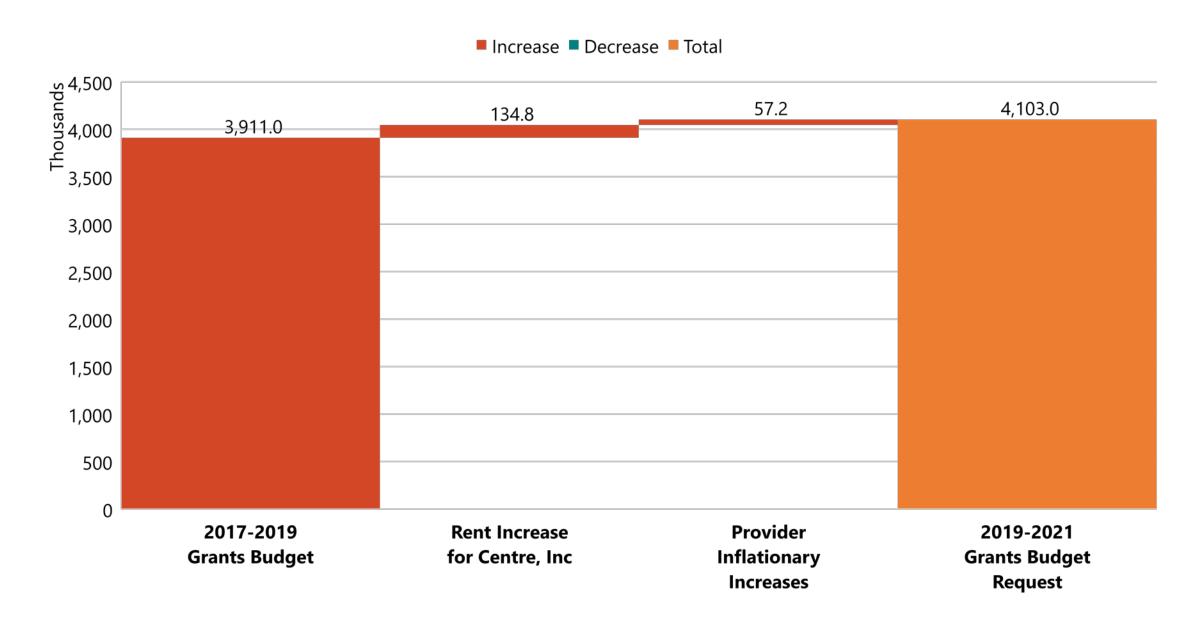
### MAJOR SALARY AND WAGES DIFFERENCES
